



# Chichester Yacht Club Notice of Race

## CYC Snowflake 2010-2011

Incorporating the Frozen Toe and Snowflake Race Series

Organising Authority: Chichester Yacht Club.

National Authority: Royal Yachting Association.

### 1 Rules

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 - 2012*.

Competitors should note that Chichester Yacht Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and expects competitors to sail in compliance with the charter.

### 2 Advertising

Advertising on hulls, spars and sails is permitted as long as it is appropriate and in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

### 3 Definitions

The event is the CYC Snowflake 2010-2011.

The event incorporates the Frozen Toe Race Series, which will run before Christmas 2010 and the Snowflake Race Series, which will run after Christmas 2010.

The event organisers encompass the organising authority, the race committee and the event support team. The race committee encompasses the principal race officer, the committee boat crew, the patrol boat personnel and the beach master, while the event support team encompasses all others that help run this event.

Veteran competitors are those over 55 years of age on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

Adult competitors are those over 18 years of age on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

Young competitors are those under 18 years of age on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

Junior competitors are those under 16 years of age on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

### 4 Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The event is open to all boats with a Portsmouth Yardstick defined in the addendum to this notice of race. Boats wishing to enter the event but do not have a Portsmouth Yardstick defined in the addendum shall contact the event organisers to agree an acceptable Portsmouth Yardstick before they enter the event. Boats entering this event should conform to the spirit of their class rules and Chichester Yacht Club would encourage all competitors to join and support their class association. The event is not open to sailboards or multihull dinghies, except the Challenger trimaran.

4.2 Each entry to a race series is limited to a boat with a specific rig. A boat that swaps its rig during a race series, even if the rig swap does not affect the boats Portsmouth Yardstick, shall be counted as a new entry to that series. This includes Lasers that swap between Standard, Radial and 4.7 rigs and boats from the Laser Picos and Topazs classes that swap their rigs. This does not preclude normal class legal rig adjustments carried out afloat.

4.3 Boats needing to sail with sail numbers differing from those under which they enter must seek approval from the race committee in writing via the entry desk prior to the first race in which they sail with the changed numbers.

4.4 During the event the parents or guardians of young competitors shall either be in or around Chichester Yacht Club or afloat participating in the event, or will inform the event organisers in writing who is acting in loco parentis on their behalf. During the event any persons acting in loco parentis shall either be in or around Chichester Yacht Club or afloat participating in the event.

4.5 Eligible competitors may enter at the entry desk in the sloop at Chichester Yacht Club on any day of the event. A parent, guardian or person acting in loco parentis of all young competitors shall sign the entry form accepting the "Parent's or guardian's declaration regarding young competitors".

#### 4.6 Entry Fees:

##### Adult competitors:

Entry fee for the Frozen Toe Series: £16.

Entry fee for the Snowflake Series: £24.

Daily entry fee: £6.

##### Young competitors:

Entry fee for the Frozen Toe Series: £8.

Entry fee for the Snowflake Series: £12.

Daily entry fee: £3.

##### Harbour dues, if not already paid:

For boats of 3m LOA or less: £0.00 (Optimists)

For boats of more than 3m LOA: £2.00 per two days sailed, or £8.00 for the whole event.

##### Dinghy park berth fees:

Adult competitor dinghy park berth fee: £35.

Young competitor dinghy park berth fee: £25.

Only those entering a complete race series may apply for a dinghy park berth.

Boats must be removed from the dinghy park on or before 6<sup>th</sup> Mar 2011.

#### 4.7 Entry Conditions:

Entries to the complete Frozen Toe Race Series will only be accepted up to 09:00 on 21<sup>st</sup> Nov 2010, otherwise the daily entry fee will be charged for each day sailed.

Entries to the complete Snowflake Race Series will only be accepted up to 11:30 on 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan 2011, otherwise the daily entry fee will be charged for each day sailed.

Chichester Yacht Club requests and hopes that all adult, and maybe some young, competitors who enter either race series would also volunteer to be part of the Race Committee on at least one day. Those competitors who help run the racing during a series in which they are competing may well receive average points for the races not sailed as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 5 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 that is valid for this event and those sailing the boat.

#### 6 Fleet Designation:

Racing shall be held for the following fleets:

Fast handicap fleet: boats with a Portsmouth Yardstick of 1060 or lower.

Medium handicap fleet: boats with a Portsmouth Yardstick in the range 1061 to 1169.

Slow handicap fleet: boats with a Portsmouth Yardstick of 1170 or higher.

Fleet boundaries may be adjusted at the briefing of the first race in a race series.

Stated warning signal times are for the first race of the day of the fast handicap fleet. The fast handicap fleet's warning signal for the second race of the day will sound as soon as possible after the first race has finished. Warning signals for the medium and slow handicap fleets should sound five and ten minutes respectively after the fast handicap fleet's warning signal, subject to there being no general recalls.

## 8 Scoring

Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series. A boat's series score will be the sum of a boat's best scores from the number of races to count. The number of races to count is shown below:

## 9 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for the competitors to decide whether their boat and those that will sail it during the event are fit to sail in the conditions they might find. Each competitor is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing and is also responsible for wearing adequate clothing for the conditions. By launching competitors confirm that their boat and those sailing it are competent to sail and compete in the event and are adequately clothed for the conditions.

The event organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the competitors or accompanying persons as a result of attending or taking part in this event and those attending this event indemnifies the event organisers against all and any costs, claims, demands and liabilities in respect of the same.

The provision of patrol boats does not relieve persons in charge, competitors and those accompanying competitors of their responsibilities.

## 10 Supporting Information

10.1 Sailing instructions and entry forms will be available at registration and may be available to download via CYC's web site.

10.2 The Exoneration Penalty, Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available during this event.

10.3 Courses will be set and races will be held on the waters known as Chichester Lake.

10.4 Prizes will be awarded as detailed in the sailing instructions.

10.6 Support boats attending this event shall register at the entry desk during any registration period.

10.7 Competitors shall accept that photographs of their boat and its crew could be taken whilst attending this event.
