#### **RYA Essential Navigation and Seamanship**

Members £140, Non-members £175 Aimed at providing a basic knowledge of navigation and safety, this 2-day course is ideal for all water users and covers charts, safety, tidal awareness, navigation, pilotage and much more.

#### **RYA Day Skipper Theory**

Members £400, Non-members £500 Run over 3 weekends, this course aims to provide sufficient knowledge to enable navigation around familiar tidal and non tidal waters by day and is ideal for aspiring skippers or those with crewing experience.

#### **RYA First Aid Course**

Members £110, Non-members £130 This course will provide you with a basic knowledge of First Aid and is aimed at people who will be using small craft inland or at sea. The course is equally suitable for cruisers, racers, dinghy sailors, windsurfers, motor boaters and ocean rowers.

### **RYA Radar Course**

Using a Radar simulator this course teaches you how to adjust the controls, interpret the picture and use radar for navigation and collision avoidance.
